

Competition Rules

1. The theme is, Great trees of Cornwall / Gwydh meur a Gernow.
2. Only one poem per entrant.
3. The competition closing date is 31st July 2009.
4. Poems must be unpublished and not accepted for publication elsewhere.
5. Poems should be no longer than 36 lines including verse breaks.
6. Poems may be written in any form but must be the original work of the entrant.
7. Poet's details or any identification marks must not appear on the entered poem.
8. The entry form must be completed and returned with the competition entry.
9. The organisers reserve the right to alter the apportioning of, or withhold the prizes.
10. Poets should retain copies of their work as entries will not be returned.
11. Entries received after the closing date will be recycled
12. Judging will be by Les Merton & Mick Paynter (Poetry Cornwall editors) with advice from members of the Great trees steering group
13. The competition judges decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding the results of the competition.
14. Prize winners will be notified.
15. The results will be published on www.greentreesofcornwall.pbwiki.com and in issue 26 of Poetry Cornwall published in October 2009.
